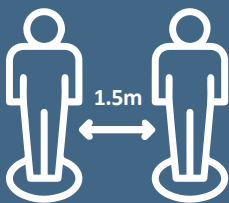


Northern Cemeteries

Attending a Northern Cemeteries Service

Maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from others.



WEAR A FACE MASK.

If you are feeling unwell or have symptoms do not attend services at Northern Cemeteries.



Please seek medical assistance.

If you have been in VIC in the last 14 days you are not permitted to enter a Northern Cemeteries site.



Anyone who has returned from overseas must complete the mandatory 14 days in self-isolation.



If self-isolation has not been completed for 14 days, the person cannot attend a Northern Cemeteries site.



Anyone who has been in one of the locations identified as a COVID-19 hotspot must follow the advice of NSW Health. You can get your latest information at the NSW Gov website: nsw.gov.au

All people attending a funeral service must supply name and contact details in the Record of Attendance.



Group singing in services is not permitted as it is considered a high-risk activity.



Condolence lines are **NOT PERMITTED**; as they encourage hand-shaking, hugging and kissing which is prohibited under safe physical distancing regulations.
