

Macquarie Park Cemetery and Crematorium presents the new Mausoleum of the Holy Way


Designed as a semi-open space to complement the surrounding area, the building provides a sanctuary for remembrance, worship and quiet reflection.

The Mausoleum of the Holy Way offers a quality range of burial and ash memorialisation options and is located adjacent to the Stations of the Cross area in the Catholic section.

Features include:

- 660 above ground crypts with natural stone (doubles and singles)
- Five distinct family vaults, each providing 12 crypt spaces
- Various columbaria spaces for ash interments (space for 2, 3 and 4 ash placements)
- Courtyard and water features at the entrance of the complex
- New landscaping including a separate reflection garden
- New amenities block

High ceiling levels and use of stone and other natural finishes gives the building a high quality and sustainable feel. Artistic elements include integration with the existing Stations of the Cross statues as well as spaces for potential display of public artworks.



Crypts

Single and double crypts available

660 crypts made up of 267 doubles and 126 singles

The new Mausoleum of the Holy Way crypts are located in three beautiful galleries namely, the Gallery of Faith, the Gallery of Peace and the Gallery of Devotion. The crypts are set within the semi-open Mausoleum, amidst an impressive sculpture garden depicting the path Jesus walked on the day of Crucifixion. Each area provides an opportunity for quiet reflection.

Price includes the complete package: interment, inscription, and ongoing maintenance with no further costs. There is easy access and parking for when visiting loved ones.

The crypts are four rows high, organised from bottom (A) to top (D), for the Gallery of Faith and the Gallery of Peace. The Gallery of Devotion features five rows high, beginning at A (bottom) to E (top).



Columbaria

Each columbarium allows for ash placements in four areas of the Mausoleum of the Holy Way. These are the Gallery of Faith, the Gallery of Peace, The Sacred Garden and The Sanctuary Each provides a unique, dignified and respectful place for the interment of ashes. The columbaria allow for 2, 3 and 4 sets of ashes to accommodate all needs.

The colombaria are six rows high, with A beginning at the bottom row, and F ending at the top. In The Sanctuary there are seven rows, with A beginning at the bottom row, and G ending at the top.

There are five sizes to choose from, depending on space required. Price includes the complete package: interment, inscription, and ongoing maintenance with no further costs. There is easy access and parking for when visiting loved ones.



Ash Memorial

The Pool of Reflection is a beautiful water feature complementing the elegant Mausoleum of The Holy Way. Set along the path of the Pool of Reflection are ash memorial placements that allow for above ground interment and have the capacity to hold 2 sets of ashes as well as special tributes or trinkets. Price includes the complete package: interment, inscription, and ongoing maintenance with no further costs. There is easy access and parking for when visiting loved ones.




Family Vaults
