Situated in a unique landscaped garden these replica sandstone rocks are designed for twin interment of ashes.

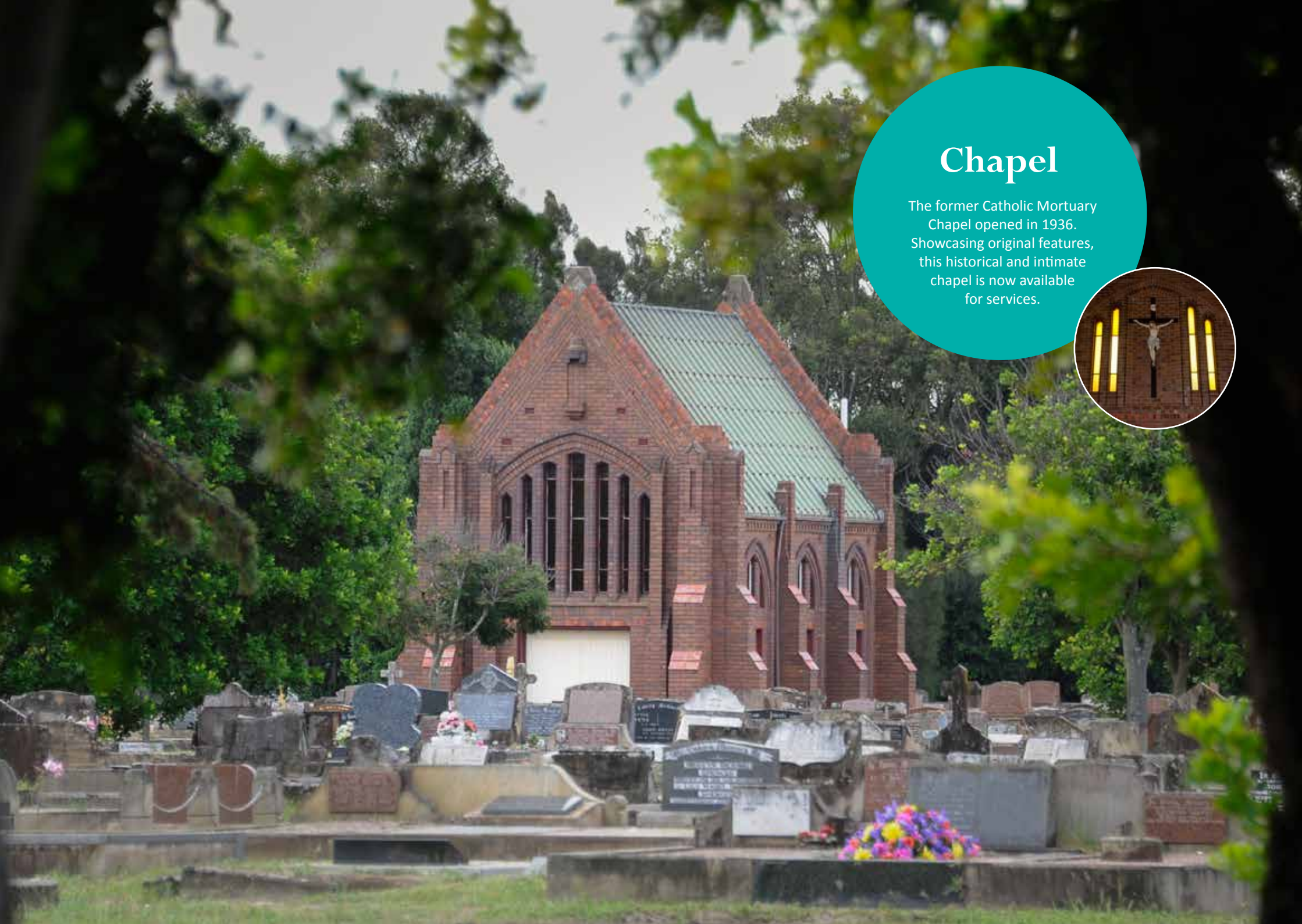
Rose Ash Garden Partner Estate

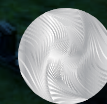
